No candidate shall be elected who is under 18 years of age or an employee of the club. <p>10. SUBSCRIPTIONS</p> <p>Every member shall pay to the club funds a subscription which shall be due as soon as (10.a he is) elected to membership and may not be paid until (10.b he is) so elected. The subscription must be paid before the member is entitle to any of the privileges of the club. The rate of subscription shall be such a sum as may from time to time be determined by the members in a general meeting being not less than £1 and not exceeding £50 per year payable on the first day of January in each Year.</p> <p>Any member who has not paid (10.c his) subscription by the 1st of February shall be considered in arrear, and if it be not paid by 1st March (10.d he) shall cease to be a member. The rate of subscription shall be such a sum as may from time to time be determined by the members in a general meeting being not less than £1 and not exceeding £50 per year payable on the first day of January in each Year.</p> <p>Any member who has not paid (10.c their) subscription by the 1st of February shall be considered in arrears, and if it be not paid by 1st March (10.d they) shall cease to be a member.
